Who: Right to Life-LIFESPAN, Inc, Oakland/Macomb and Wayne/Downriver Chapters

What: 8 charter buses, nearly 400 passengers (students plus adult chaperones) leaving from 1637 W. Big Beaver, Troy, MI 48084 for trip to the National March for Life in Washington DC. Most passengers are area high school and college students who will travel all night and arrive in Washington DC in time to participate in the annual March for Life event marking the 40th anniversary of the United States Supreme Court decision in Roe v Wade. They will attend the Youth Rally at the Comcast Center and have the honor of laying a wreath at the tomb of the Unknown at Arlington National Cemetery.

When and Where: Buses leave from the Oakland/Macomb chapter office, 1637 W. Big Beaver, Troy in two groups on the evening of January 24th. One group of 4 buses leaves at 6:30pm,(drop off for passengers begins at 5:45pm) travels to Madonna University in Livonia to pick up west side passengers and proceeds to Washington DC. The second group of buses leaves 1637 W. Big Beaver, Troy at 7:30(drop off for passengers begins at 6:45pm) and travels directly to Washington, DC.

<u>Why</u>: January 22nd marks the 40th anniversary of the Supreme Court decision (Roe v Wade) that made abortion legal for the full 9 months of pregnancy. These marchers, and literally thousands like them from all over the US, march to commemorate the approximately 55,000,000 plus lives lost to abortion. They march to encourage our nation and its leaders to provide better help to women and families facing an unexpected pregnancy. Destroying human life seems a poor way to solve human problems.
